It has been a brilliant week in school with the main highlight being the visit of James Ketchell on Wednesday. James is a serial adventurer and, in 2014, became the first and only person to have rowed across the

Atlantic Ocean, summitted Mount Everest and cycled 18000 miles around the world. In 2019, he flew his open cockpit gyroplane over 24000 nautical miles circumnavigating the world in 175 days (setting an aviation speed record). James delivered assemblies to all the children and then workshops for our children in KS2.

Earlier in the week, Mr Spence took a Y3/4 football team to play in a tournament at Goals in Kirkstall. The children had a brilliant time and represented the school superbly.
