Managing positive COVID-19 cases over the Easter break... During the first 6 days of the school holidays, we will play an important role in the test and trace procedures for the pupils and staff in school.



If your child tests positive for COVID-19, having developed symptoms **within 48 hours** since last being in school, you must contact school. Please email the office marked **FAO Mr. Cooke**. This email will be checked daily before 09:00 up until and including Wednesday 7 April. Making early contact will definitely help: if your child has developed symptoms and is being tested then you should email the office immediately whilst we await the results.

Where pupils test positive for coronavirus during the holidays, having developed symptoms more than 48 hours since being in school, you are not required to email school. Parents should follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.

If pupils need to self-isolate due to contact with a positive case during the holidays, school does not need to be informed about this until the first day of the Summer term.
