Happy New Year!

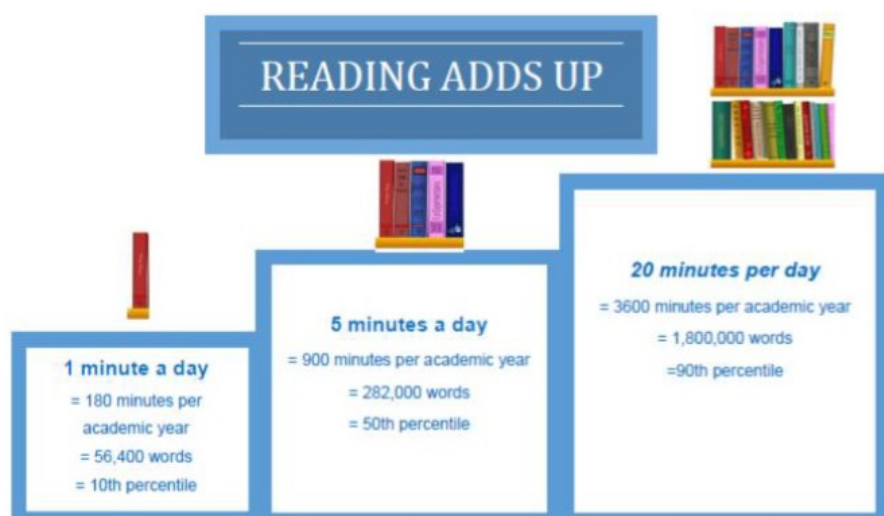
I hope that this issue finds you and your families well and that you had a chance to relax over the Christmas break.
