

#### KS2 Statutory Assessments Test (SATs) Results:

Historically, all schools have been required to publish Key Stage 2 test results on their website. The last published data on our website is from 2019. In 2020 and 2021, schools did not complete KS2 SATs due to the pandemic. We did complete the tests in 2022 but we are not required to publish this data. This decision has been made by the Secretary of State. This is a shame as our test results are very positive and our progress measures are too; they are worthy of sharing with you all.
